RCIA includes preparation for the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil.

RCIA is right for you if you:

- ~ have never been baptized
- ~ are a baptized Protestant and would like to become Catholic
- ~ are a baptized Catholic but never received Holy Communion

RCIA meets twice a month on Mondays at 7 p.m. in the Sister Lucy Center beginning Monday, September 19.
