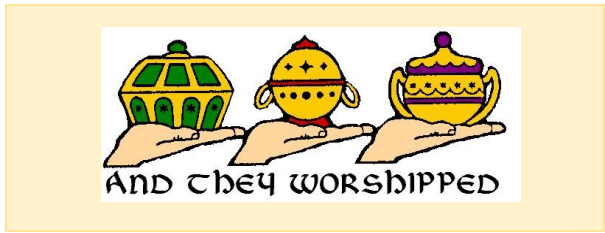

Symbolon The Catholic Faith Explained

Session 1: The Journey of Faith

An old proverb says the longest journey begins with a single step. The Spiritual Formation Committee of Saint Clare and Saint Paschal invites you to take a step toward a deeper and richer experience of your Catholic faith that will last a lifetime.

This is the first of a ten-part study of the Catholic faith entitled *Symbolon*. We will gather once a month to reflect on God's plan of salvation for us, basing our study on the Creed. Each session includes prayer, video presentations and time for discussion.

So, what is *Symbolon*? In the early Church, Christians described their Creed, their summary statement of faith, as the *symbolon*. The Creed served as a means of Christian recognition. Someone who confessed the Creed could be identified as a true Christian.

Our first session will be held both on January 8 from 6:40 p.m. to 8:10 p.m. in the Kazel Room of Saint Paschal, and on January 11 from 12:30 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the Harvest Room at Saint Clare. There is no registration fee, so please just come to become part of this new and exciting adult faith formation program.
